APPLICATION FOR OUT OF STATE TUITION DIFFERENTIAL WAIVER
ECONOMIC ADVANTAGE

As of the first day of classes for the term, an economic advantage waiver has been granted. This is based on the facts that a dependent or independent student can provide clear evidence that the student or the student's parent, spouse, or U.S. court-appointed guardian has relocated to the State of Georgia to accept full-time, self-sustaining employment and has established domicile in the State of Georgia. Relocation to the state must be for reasons other than enrolling in an institution of higher education. This waiver will expire 12 months from the date the move was made to Georgia. An affected student must petition for residency status after 12 months living in the State of Georgia and must provide additional documentation according to established procedures at Columbus State University. I also understand this waiver, if approved, is valid for 12 months from the time I accepted employment for the State of Georgia and I must submit a Petition for Georgia Residency once this waiver expires.
