

**Columbus State University**  
**APPLICATION FOR OUT OF STATE TUITION DIFFERENTIAL WAIVER**  
**NON-RESIDENT STUDENT**

As of the first day of classes for the term, a Non-Resident Student waiver may be granted to a dependent or independent student whose parent, spouse, or U.S. court-appointed legal guardian has maintained domicile in Georgia for at least 12 consecutive months so long as the student can provide clear evidence showing the relationship to the parent, spouse, or U.S. court-appointed legal guardian has existed for at least 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the first day of classes for the term. This waiver will expire 12 months from the date the waiver was granted. An affected student must petition for residency status after 12 months and must then provide additional documentation according to established procedures at Columbus State University.
