APPLICATION FOR OUT OF STATE TUITION DIFFERENTIAL WAIVER FOR
RECENTLY SEPARATED MILITARY PERSONNEL

A student who, as of the first day of the term of enrollment, can provide documentation supporting that his or her separation from the military has occurred within the last 12 months, and he or she has established domicile in the State of Georgia, may qualify immediately for an out-of state tuition differential waiver which will expire 12 months from the date the student was separated from the military. An affected student must petition for residency status after 12 months and must provide additional documentation according to established procedures at Columbus State University.
